

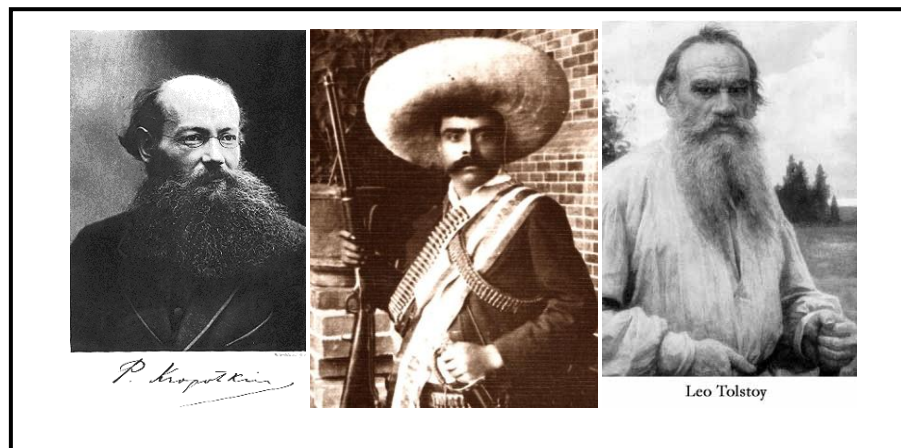
How to “dress down” for anti-capitalist demonstrations

These looks are *so hot right now* amongst anarchists and revolutionaries:



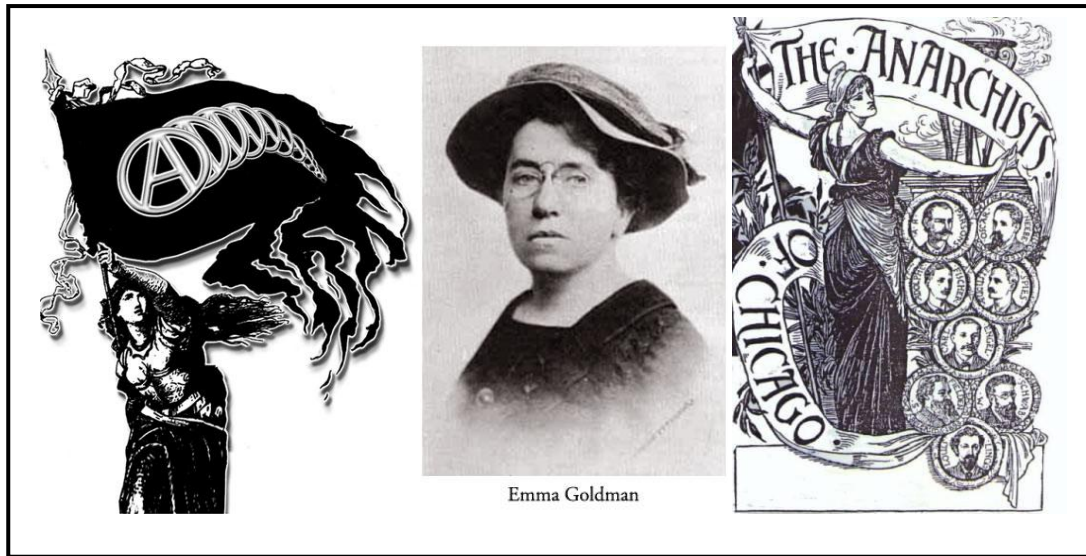
Alternatively, follow style guru Leon Trotsky’s advice for this season and wear “elegant wide trousers and your hair like a pimp”.
